Responsibilities:

Parents and local LEA's and agencies work together with The Bureau of Special Education Adviser in the monitoring

Process special education programs and provide input and recommendations to the team for compliance of regulations.

Assist the Administration in carrying out the Right to Education Consent Agreement.

Assist parents of students with special needs in understanding the laws/regulations

Refer systemic issues identified locally to the appropriate intermediate unit, LEA, local agency, Bureau of Special Education Advisor, or to the STF chairperson for clarification, recommendation or solution.

Review recommendations of the State Task Force Encourage cooperation with public and private agencies which provide services to school-age children with special

Identify local needs and problems and develop recommendations for consideration by appropriate agencies. Recommend solutions to problems in areas of concern

needs.

Review Intermediate Unit and District Special Education Plans

Assist the State Task Force in the collection of data to determine the effectiveness of the Right to Education Consent Agreement.
